VENUES AND TRANSPORT

GrEAT! – We try to get out and about around Oxford as much as we can, so if we are going bowling or to the pub then just meet us there. If we are having an activities night then we will be in the St. Clement's Family Centre (see below for location). If you take the bus, your ticket will be refunded.

KEEN is an organisation of Oxford and Oxford Brookes University students who along with local people provide sporting and recreational activities for children and young adults with special needs. During each week of the Oxford University term we run four different activities (see termcard overleaf, for details of what is happening this term) – here is a brief run-down of what happens at each of our sessions....

ALLSortS is our Saturday sports session and is the biggest session of the KEEN week. The afternoon is divided into two halves the first for the younger, and the second for our older athletes. Activities can include anything from: football, basketball, rounders, playground games, athletics, tag rugby and the occasional bouncy castle!

Absolutely no sporting ability is required, just plenty of energy and enthusiasm!

Zig-Zag is a drama and craft workshop for under 18's, sessions are run by our volunteers, and involve a range of arts, crafts, music, drama, and games based around the theme for the term. Previous themes have included fairytales, west end shows and the most recent theme being festivals of the world. The emphasis at Zig-Zag is on integration and creativity, and the fun seems to arrive in abundance!

KEEN Teens is a social club aimed at children from 11 to 17 years with structured activities such as quizzes, cooking, crafts, talent shows, bingo, fun science experiments, computer games and more!

GrEAT! is KEEN's social club for over 18s and as such is the most relaxed session of the KEEN week. GrEAT meets every Monday for a variety of activities and 'themed' nights. Sessions, over the past term, have included a musical extravaganza, a film night, a computer game night as well as trips to the pub and the bowling alley.

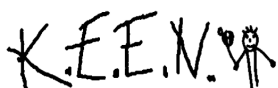
Olympics! : Our end of year finale! Saturday 19th June: 1.45-5pm, at New College Sports Ground.
