is an organisation of Oxford and Oxford Brookes University students (our 'coaches') who provide sporting and recreational activities for children and young adults with special needs (our 'athletes'). Every week we run four different activity sessions – here is a brief run-down of what happens at each of our sessions....

**ALLSORTS** is our Sat sports session and is the biggest session of the KEEN week. The afternoon is divided into two halves for first the younger, and then the older athletes. Activities can include anything from: football, basketball, hockey, playground games, athletics, tag rugby and the occasional bouncy castle! **No sporting ability is required, just plenty of energy and enthusiasm!**

**Zig-Zag** is a drama and craft workshop for under 18's. Sessions are run by our volunteers, and involve a range of arts, crafts, music, drama, and games based around the theme for the term—this time: nursery rhymes! Previous themes have included Myths and Legends, Shakespeare and Modern Children's films. The emphasis at Zig-Zag is on integration and creativity.

**KEEN TEENS** is a social club aimed at children and young adults from 11 to 19 years with structured activities such as quizzes, cooking, crafts, talent shows, bingo, fun science experiments, and computer games.

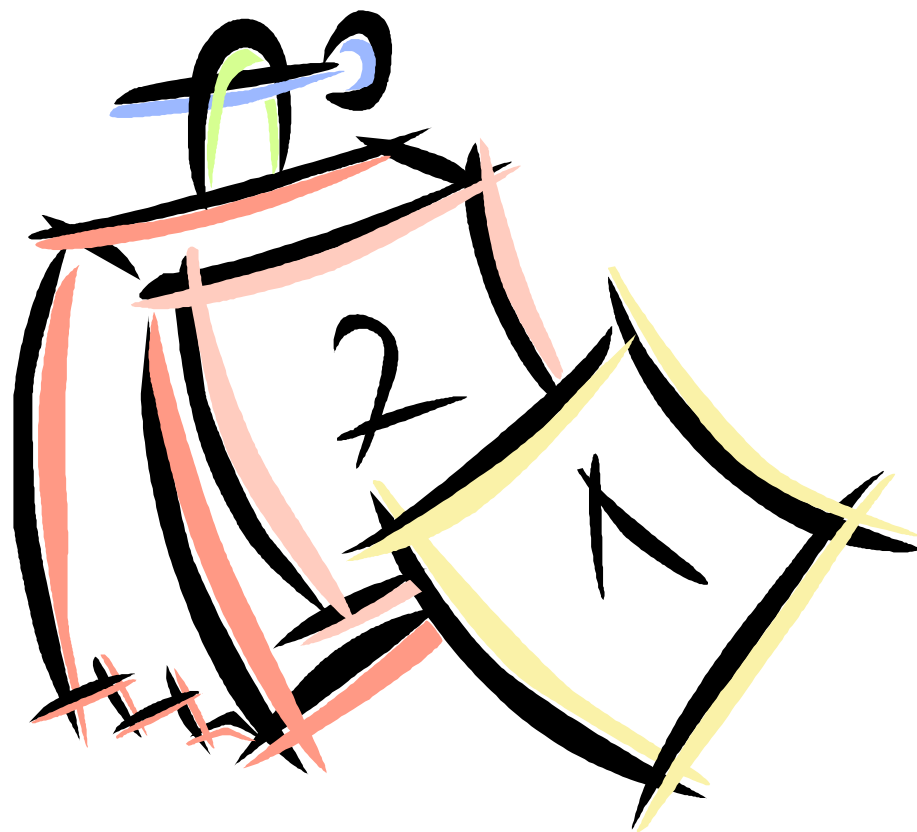
